

Terms and Conditions

No entries will be returned.

The MMPA reserves the right to use the winning entries for exhibit, promotion and/or in a publication of collected works.

The MMPA reserves the right not to make an award in any category if, in the judges' opinion, no entry merits one, or if there are not enough entrants to make it a fair competition.

Entrants may be required to provide supporting documents (notes, references and other material) at the judges' request.

Awards in the written categories are open to materials published and produced as original material. First-rights only will be considered for awards.

Decisions as to all aspects of the competition are final and binding.

Entrants must notify the MMPA in the event that any submission is, or subsequently becomes, the subject of any legal action so that the MMPA may take appropriate steps to avoid legal complications that could arise from republication.

If an apology or retraction related to an article has been printed prior to submission; it must be attached to the entry. If an article that has been entered becomes the subject of an apology or retraction before the awards presentation, the MMPA must be notified.
